## IAN'S INSTRUMENTS

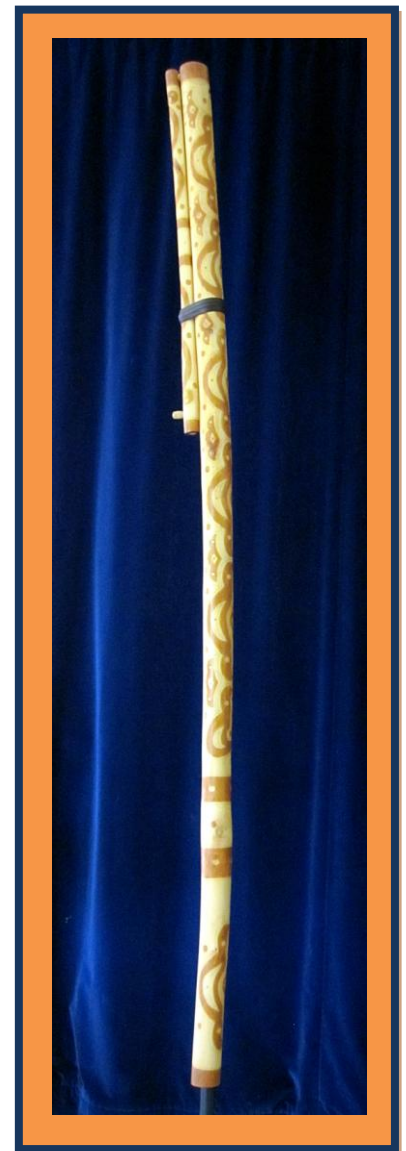
*Interesting instruments used on the FunMusic recordings... from the collection of Ian Blake*

### FUJARA

The fujara (pronounced *foo-ya-ra*) is a wind instrument and comes from Slovakia. It is an end-blown flute, and was originally played by shepherds.

A fujara is played standing up because it is so long (this one is about 1.6 metres tall).
